Transportation Services

Guilford County Transportation & Mobility Services

FREE transportation service for residents who have Medicaid and/or no other means of transportation to doctors' offices, hospitals, pharmacies, dialysis centers, clinics, dentists and other health-related visits or medical appointments. Lift-equipped vehicles are available for riders in wheelchairs and guide animals are permitted. Also available is door-to-door service — the driver will come to your door and assist with varying types of disabilities, accommodations can be arranged to meet individual needs. Transportation services may include bus tickets, gas vouchers, taxis or vans.

Languages: Reservationists can accommodate over 150 different languages; drivers are **NOT** multi-lingual.

Note: Children may accompany adults if necessary; you must have a child's safety seat if required by law.

New riders must complete an eligibility determination 3 days in advance. You must call for a reservation before 3:00 pm on the business day before your appointment.

When you call for a trip reservation, you will need to have the following information:

- Your name and pick-up address.
- The address of your destination.
- Your Medicaid number.
- The date and time of your trip.
- Your telephone number and a telephone number at your destination.
- Whether you are in a wheelchair, or will need other special assistance.
