- * Prior to using this program you must complete a SCAT application. This application process can take up to 21 days.*

Guilford County Transportation & Mobility Services

- Program:** Provides transportation to doctors' offices, hospitals, pharmacies, dialysis centers, clinics, dentists and other health-related visits or medical appointments for persons in need. Lift-equipped vehicles are available for riders in wheelchairs and guide animals are permitted. Door-to-door service is available the driver will come to your door and assists riders with varying types of disabilities and can arrange accommodations to meet individual needs. Transportation services may include bus tickets, gas vouchers, taxis or vans.

- Cost:** Free for residents who have Medicaid and who have no other means of transportation
- Languages:** Reservationists can accommodate over 150 different languages; drivers are **NOT** multi-lingual
- Childcare:** Children may accompany adults if necessary; you must have a children's safety seat if required by law

New riders must complete an eligibility determination 3 days in advance. You must call for reservation before 3:00pm on the business day before your appointment.

When you call for a trip reservation, you will need to have the following information:

- your name and pick-up address
- the address of your destination
- your Medicaid number
- the date and time of your trip
- your telephone number and a telephone number at your destination
- you are in a wheelchair, or will need other special assistance
